I enclose two copies of a declaration submitted to the Department of National Defence by 29 Japanese Canadians in the Toronto area who have volunteered for General Service with the Canadian Armed Forces. I would suggest that copies of this declaration be placed on the file of each of these men for record purposes as an indication of loyalty to this country.

National Defence states that they have also received about 45 other applications for enlistment from Japanese Canadians, and we have asked that full particulars be sent to us on these and any future applications. When these are received they will be passed along to you in order that you may record same on the files of the persons concerned.

DECLARATION

To the Minister of National Defence,
Ottawa, Ontario.

We, the undersigned Japanese Canadians, in the City of Toronto, County of York and Province of Ontario, believing in the democratic principles for which this country is at war, and believing that there should be no discriminatory treatment in the rights and responsibilities of all Canadian citizens, do hereby declare our willingness to enlist in the Armed Forces of Canada for General Service on the same basis as all other Canadians.
